

Direct payment for uninsured patients

You have just reported to the Emergency Department of Spijkenisse Medical Centre for a non-life threatening medical issue. It has also been established that you are not in possession of a Dutch EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) or E-111 health insurance card. This means that the costs for your treatment cannot be claimed from a health insurance company.

For this reason, we can only treat you once you have paid the costs yourself. The triage nurse of the emergency department can help you with the payment settlement.

Shown on the right are the rates that the Spijkenisse Emergency Clinic charges. These rates have been compiled as carefully as possible according to Dutch guidelines. The rates are per consultation and are only an advance payment for the consultation. For continued treatment, there may be additional charges.

We would like to remind you once again that if you cannot pay, no treatment will be given.
